OVERNIGHT CAMPING

Make your experience at The Adventure Park fully immersive with our Overnight Camping option!

CAMPSITES AND DETAILS

We have 5 on-site campsites available. They all feature a large fire-ring and two picnic tables, and are stocked with firewood and water (two 5-gallon jugs) before your arrival.

PREMIUM SITES:

These sites are located at the front of the Park, and have closer access to bathrooms. They are **Eagle's Landing**, **Rambler's Roost**, and **Robin's Nest**.

PRIMITIVE SITES:

These sites are located at the back of the Park and are more removed from the Park's facilities. They are **Bandit's Hideaway** and **Poplar Den**.

Eagle's Landing, Rambler's Roost, Robin's Nest, and Bandit's Hideaway can accommodate up to 20 four-person tents. Poplar Den is perfect for 10 or fewer tents.

PREPARATION CHECKLIST

To get things ready...

- Send this PDF to every unit leader.**
Including the senior youth leader who may be called upon to do some—or all!—of the organization.
- Consider timing options for your unit.**
 - Any day through the summer
 - After dark climbing under the lights.
 - Weekends (Friday - Sunday) from March through December.
 - Pair your climbing adventure with on-site camping.
- If you have never been to the Park, ask us about a site visit for unit leaders.**
- Once you have approval, pick a date and call us to make the reservation.**
Remember that some of the more popular times fill up quickly, so you'll want to get the approval and reservation made as early in the year as possible.
- Tell us of any add-ons you'd like to include when making your reservation.**
Whether you'd like to book one of our campsites, or you're interested in our Forest Science packets... just let us know, so that we can help you plan for the best adventure possible!
- Prepare the communication to participants and/or parents: we have waivers all kids must complete before arrival.**
This waiver is available through a unique link we'll send to you once your deposit is made to guarantee your reservation. This waiver can be filled out easily by everyone online.

And when you get to the Park...

- Drop off in our unloading zone, near our Park Store, and check in.**
- Set up your reserved picnic table and area.**
- Get ready to have a blast!**

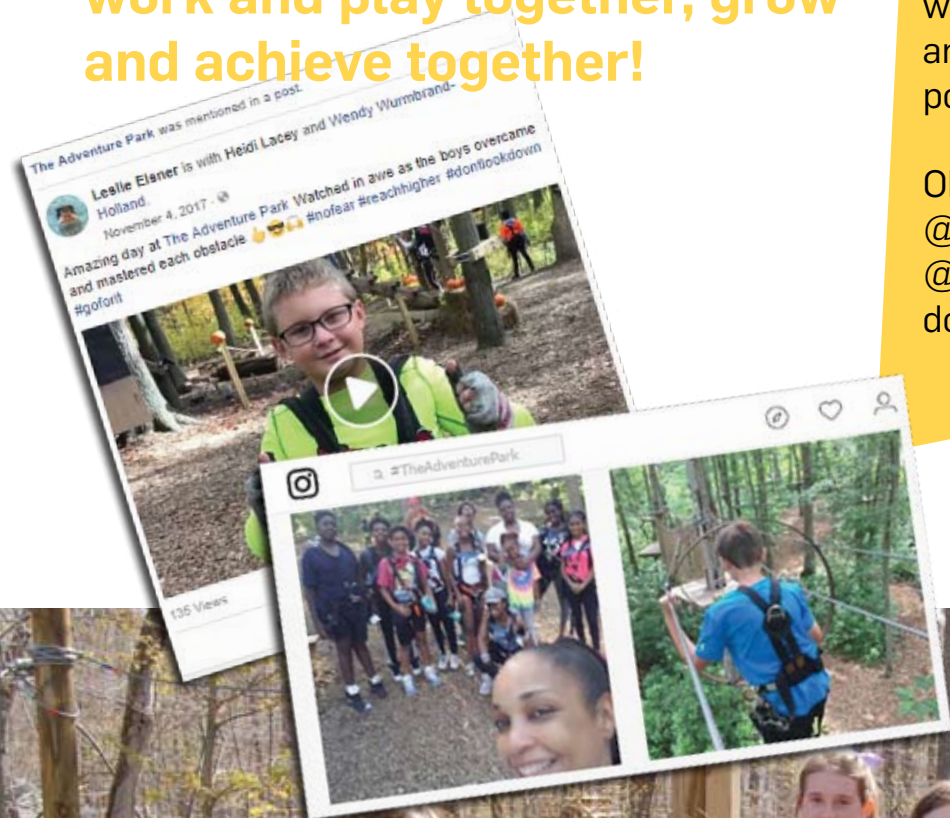
